The Series is designed to offer a diversified portfolio of dividend-paying U.S. equity securities. Using a systematic process with a focus on mid- to large-capitalization U.S. companies, securities are selected based on factors such as free cash flow generation and earnings power, minimum dividend yield, dividend sustainability, and financial health.

- Seeking exposure to companies with meaningful growth potential due to high free cash flow yields and earning power
